Rosemaling, a Norwegian word meaning rose painting, dates back to the 1700's. Rosemaling was primarily done on wooden surfaces to brighten the homes and churches of the people of Norway. The oil based paint they used consisted of earthy colors

and each color had a light, medium and dark value. The pieces on display at the 'Resort to Rosemaling' will show the different styles of rosemaling, each named for the regions of Norway in which they originated.

Located 1 mi. East on highway 3 to the Shellbrook airstrip, turn left and travel 3 miles north on the grid.
